Admission Requirements

Your admission average will be calculated on five senior courses numbered 30, 30-1, or 31, including English Language Arts 30-1. For admission purposes, Brescia will accept either five acceptable academic courses, or four acceptable academic courses plus one acceptable option. For specialized programs you may be required to present prerequisite courses in specific subject areas.

To be considered for admission, you must present a completed Alberta High School Diploma, or prove that you will complete your diploma before entering first year studies at Brescia.

Transcript Information

You should submit your official transcripts directly to the Brescia Admissions Office. If you have applied and do not have final grades to submit, please contact your Admissions Officer about submitting first semester or midterm grades.

All documents should be sent in an envelope sealed by your institution. It is your responsibility to ensure the necessary documentation reaches our Admissions Office for review.

Important Offer Information

Conditional offers of admission may be granted on first semester grades. Please see our most recent admissions chart for more information regarding minimum requirements. Offers of admission go out on a rolling basis beginning late January throughout the summer. If you have questions about the status of your application please contact your Admissions Officer.

The Admissions Office will also evaluate applicants for alternate offers of admission to the Social Science program for those applicants who do not meet the minimum admission requirements for their program of choice.

Entrance Scholarships

Brescia offers an unlimited number of entrance scholarships beginning at 80%. There is no application required. If your admission average is 80% or above, you are guaranteed (at minimum) a Brescia Merit Entrance Scholarship worth \$1500. The value of your scholarship depends on your final admission average. Entrance scholarships are renewable for each year of study at Brescia provided you meet the conditions of carrying a continuing scholarship. Please contact the Registrar's Office at Brescia for additional information.

Brescia University College is affiliated with The University of Western Ontario. All students enrolled at Brescia are also considered "Western" students. Upon graduation, you receive your degree from The University of Western Ontario.
