Confirmation of Enrollment for OSAP has occurred and will continue as applications continue to process.

**September 26th** - Opt-out deadline for the Health and Dental Plan

**October 15th** - General Bursary Deadline

## Updates from the Business Office

### Fall/Winter Tuition Fees

### Entrance/Continuing Brescia Scholarships

-Scholarships and awards are applied directly to fees owing and will appear as a credit on your personal invoice. First installments are thereby reduced by applicable scholarships/awards. If your tuition is assessed on a per course basis (ie. Enrollment in 3.5 courses or less), your scholarship and/or award will be prorated accordingly.

### Health/Dental Opt-Out

-As part of your ancillary/compulsory fees, any student registered in 3.5 courses or more is charged for Health/Dental Plan and a Bus Pass. Students can choose to opt-out of the Health and/or Dental Plan at [www.studentbenefits.ca](http://www.studentbenefits.ca) no later than **September 26th, 2018** for a refund.

## Updates from the Financial Aid Office

### Bursaries

Brescia students with financial need are encouraged to submit a 2018-2019 Financial Assistance Application to be considered for a bursary. Bursaries are non-repayable, taxable grants available to domestic students. Applications are due **October 15th**, annually. Students are encouraged to apply early to assist with their academic year costs. Applications are reviewed in late fall and students will be contacted by their UWO email regarding a decision.

### Bold Works - Work Study Programs

The program is now CLOSED for the 2018-2019 academic year, and all students, who applied by the deadline, should have been contacted regarding the decision on their application.

### Additional Brescia Scholarships/Awards/Bursaries

Brescia is pleased to be able to offer a number of scholarships, awards and bursaries that have been funded by individual donors, corporations, Faculties, Departments, as well as Brescia University College. Below is a list of the awards/scholarships/bursaries that require an application for consideration. I would encourage you to review the list, and apply to any for which you meet the criteria. Some are open to International students as well (ex. BUCSC awards). The deadline to apply for the awards listed below is October 15th, 2018.

#### To Apply:

- 1) Complete a "2018-2019 Financial Assistance Application." If you have already submitted this please do not complete again, as it is on file.
- 2) Complete the "Personal Profile" and attach the required supporting documentation (ex. letters of reference, letter of explanation, etc.) and submit to the HIVE at Brescia (Attn: Financial Aid Office). **\*\*Students are encouraged to submit one Personal Profile cover sheet for the awards for which they wish to be considered and a separate letter of explanation. However, we can carry the reference letters over for consideration of each award.**

#### List of Awards/Scholarships/Bursaries:

**Catherine Powell Award** – Foods and Nutrition student entering 3rd year, cumulative average of 75%, active community volunteer, financial need, Ontario resident.

**Linda Buchanan Memorial Award** - Second, third or fourth year Foods and Nutrition student, volunteerism in more than one area, main area should be health or social services - especially psychology.

**Martha Molina Steers Leadership Award** – Foods and Nutrition student entering final year, 80% average, interest in international nutrition work, volunteer in F&N activities in community, leadership role in student associations at BUC.

**Ottawa Home Economics Association Award** - Foods and Nutrition or Human Ecology student (preference from Ottawa region) who volunteers in the community and is an active participant in student professional development associations while maintaining high academic standing.

**Kathryn Munn Dimensions of Leadership Scholarship** – awarded to a student that exemplifies the DOL program's commitment to developing the leaders of tomorrow, demonstrated financial need, and Ontario resident.

**Sister Mary Frances Dorschell Scholarship** – 3rd or 4th year full-time student in French for Teaching program, minimum 80% average, demonstrated volunteer work (Financial Assistance application not required).

**Brescia Alumnae Reunion Award** – Full-Time transfer student, minimum 70% average, no continuing scholarship, demonstrated community involvement (Financial Assistance application not required).

**BUCSC Recognition Award 4th Year** – 4th year full-time student, minimum 70% average in previous year, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities that have enhanced leadership, educational, and/or professional development. Demonstrated financial need.

**BUCSC Recognition Award 3rd Year** – 3rd year full-time student, minimum 70% average in previous year, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities that have enhanced leadership, educational, and/or professional development. Demonstrated financial need.

**BUCSC Recognition Award 2nd Year** – 2nd year full-time student, minimum 70% average in previous year, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities that have enhanced leadership, educational, and/or professional development. Demonstrated financial need.

**BUCSC Recognition Award Mature Student** – mature student, minimum 70% average in previous year, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities that have enhanced leadership, educational, and/or professional development. Demonstrated financial need.

**BUCSC Recognition Award Part-Time Student** – part-time student, minimum 70% average in previous year, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities that have enhanced leadership, educational, and/or professional development. Demonstrated financial need.

**Franca Fortner Award** – 2nd or 3rd year student who volunteers in her community, demonstrated financial need, Ontario resident.

**Heather MacDougall Memorial Bursary** - Financial need, 3rd year student, significant volunteering, Ontario resident.

**Ilya Costantini-Stoll Memorial Award** – 3rd or 4th year Honours BA program and is involved in charity/volunteer work.

**Madeleine Hart Award** - 2nd, 3rd or 4th year Brescia student with a minimum average of 70% who is involved in volunteerism and has an understanding for women's issues as demonstrated through either course or volunteer placements/practicums and is eligible for OSAP (Ontario Resident).

**Dr. Joan Francolini Scholarship** - Entering third year of full-time study, minimum 80% average in second year on 5.0 courses taken during the Fall-Winter at Brescia, demonstrated leadership on campus, in her community, or within her family, as evidenced by two letters of reference.

**Patricia & Laura Gray Award** - Volunteers in the community, demonstrated financial need. The Congress of Black Women, Dr. Marlene MacLeish Award – average of 70%, is or will be involved with the CBW, financial need, Ontario resident.

**Patricia Doig Leadership Award** - Full-time student in her third or fourth year in the Major in Dimensions of Leadership program or its equivalent. Demonstrated commitment to the Ursuline value of building community through her leadership volunteer activities within the Brescia community, the London community and/or beyond. Have a minimum average of 70% in the previous year and must meet all of the above criteria.

**Zomaron Make A Difference Award** - Full-time student entering second, third, or fourth year. Demonstrated commitment to Brescia's value of building community through leadership in volunteer activities within Brescia, the London community, or beyond. Minimum 70% average from previous year.

**The Congress of Black Women, Dr. Marlene MacLeish Award** – average of 70%, is or will be involved with the CBW, financial need, Ontario resident.
