Tips for Registering for your courses in the Summer

Brescia has a Registration Hotline open 8:00am-4:00pm at 519-432-8353 ext. 20113 and brescia@uwo.ca. If you have problems registering, please contact us! When contacting the Registration Hotline, Academic Advisors and Registration Assistants, please include the following information:

- First and Last Name
- Student Number
- Course Number
- Class Number (4-5 digit number associate with class on timetable)

Including this information will ensure that our staff can deal with your requests in a timely manner.

Before contacting us about Registration issues, please be sure that you have checked the following:

- Please use the timetable and Draft My Schedule to ensure that your courses do not conflict
- Please ensure you have the prerequisites for the courses you wish to take
- Watch for courses listed as Priority or Restricted in the Timetable. Priority courses are open to only those students in the programs/faculties listed until July 21st. The Priority is then lifted on July 21st at 9:30am and you can try to register for priority classes at that time. Restricted courses will indicate if they are opening up to students outside the program/faculty in most cases these courses cannot be added unless you have special permission from that faculty.
