As you prepare to arrive on campus next week, and begin classes on Thursday September 6, 2018; some reminders...

1. Course Registration: Make sure you double check your timetable and room assignments. To view your personal weekly schedule, you can access it through [Student Centre](#) under **Academics - My Weekly Schedule**. You can change your course registration (Add/Drop) on Student Centre until Friday September 14th.

2. Lockers: There are a limited number of lockers on campus available for the cost of \$50.00 for full lockers, (valid September 6, 2018-April 30, 2019). Sign up will begin at 8:00am in the Living Room on September 6th. Remaining lockers will be available through the Hive. Remember to bring your own lock for your locker assignment.

3. Bus Pass and Student Cards: There has been a change to the locations/process for student card and bus pass pick-up.

- Upper year students (especially fourth-year students), **who began their studies before September 2016**. These students will **require a paper pass**, available at Western. For these students only, pick up will be:
 - **UCC atrium: August 31 10AM-3PM**
 - **In Mustang Lounge: September 5 11:00am-3:00pm; September 6 9:00am-4:00pm; September 7 10:00am-3:00pm**
- Returning students **who began their studies after September 2016**, will require no further action. Their student cards will be updated with the new bus pass cycle (September 1, 2018 - August 31, 2019). Stickers for the Mustang Express (late night shuttle service) are not required for the service anymore, and will not be distributed this year.
- **New to Brescia students**, beginning their studies this year, will be able to pick up their student card/bus pass:
 - On Move-In Day - Sunday, September 2 at the Bottega Kiosk (beside Starbucks) in the Mercato between 10:00am-4:00pm
 - Beginning August 30 (today) at Hive during regular hours.

Aside from move-in day, the Bottega kiosk will no longer act as a satellite pick up location for bus passes, student cards, and student planners.
