**All ancillary fees are mandatory** except for the USC Health and USC Dental Plans and the Orientation Fee, which students must pay for but can then opt-out of. To opt-out of USC Health and USC Dental Plan go to [www.usc.uwo.ca/health](http://www.usc.uwo.ca/health); students must opt out of the plan(s) by September 30, 2016 in order to obtain a refund (to be applied against fees owing, if any). For details of the plans go to [www.studentbenefits.ca](http://www.studentbenefits.ca). Details regarding opt-out of the Orientation Fee will be provided as soon as they are available. Check our website [www.brescia.uwo.ca](http://www.brescia.uwo.ca) for updates. The Brescia Off Campus Council Fee is not charged to students residing in Clare Hall. The Brescia Ring Payment Plan Fee is collected from students in Years 2 to 4 and applied to the purchase of a Brescia Ring that each student will receive upon graduation. Contributions made towards the Ring Payment Plan are refundable upon request if a student withdraws from Brescia prior to graduating.

**FEES** - This fee schedule does not include additional costs such as books and supplies, late fees, unsealing fees, NSF fees, parking fees or service fees. **USC HEALTH AND DENTAL PLAN FEES** - These fees are billable to any student taking a total course load of 3.5 or higher. Students must pay for but can then opt-out of. To opt-out of USC Health and USC Dental Plan go to [www.usc.uwo.ca/health](http://www.usc.uwo.ca/health); students must opt out of the plan(s) by September 30, 2016 in order to obtain a refund (to be applied against fees owing, if any). For details of the plans go to [www.studentbenefits.ca](http://www.studentbenefits.ca)

**BUS PASS FEES** - Bus pass fees are billable to any student taking a minimum of 3.5 courses over the academic year and are mandatory fees.

**RESIDENCE FEES** - Meal plans are mandatory, non-refundable and cannot be carried forward to the next academic year. All residence rooms are equipped with internet (RezNet). The cost of RezNet is included in the residence fee.

**PAYMENT OPTIONS** - Students can pay their fees online as a bill payment through their online personal banking (**pay Brescia University College not Western University**) and use your student number as the account number. We also accept cash (\$500 maximum limit), cheque, money order and debit card. Students should contact Deb Van Belois in the Business Office at extension 28308 or by email to [business@uwo.ca](mailto:business@uwo.ca) to discuss any fee issues prior to the first instalment due date of August 10, 2016. Second instalment of fees is due December 1, 2016. **Third party sponsored students must request that their sponsor submit a sponsorship letter to Brescia (Deb Van Belois) prior to the due date of fees guaranteeing the tuition for the academic year. It is the student's responsibility to ensure the fees are paid by the due date.**

**SCHOLARSHIPS** - Scholarships are awarded based on merit (marks). Scholarships are applied directly to student accounts. Students who are eligible for a scholarship may deduct this amount from their first payment. For tax reporting purposes, if you are awarded a scholarship, please supply your Social Insurance Number to the Business Office. Questions concerning eligibility for or amount of an admission or continuing scholarship should be directed to the Brescia Registrar's Office at (519) 858-5151.

**BURSARIES** - Bursaries are non-repayable financial awards made on the basis of financial need. Awarded bursaries are applied directly to the student's account. Students are also eligible to apply as needed during the course of the academic year. Work Study Bursaries provide an opportunity to work in various positions offered at Brescia. The application for General and Work Study Bursaries can be found on Brescia's website. Bursary enquiries should be directed to Brescia Financial Aid at extension 28382 or by email to [brfinaid@uwo.ca](mailto:brfinaid@uwo.ca).

**OSAP** - Students with a course load of 60% (3 full courses) or more are eligible to apply for full-time OSAP funding. Students should apply online at <http://osap.gov.on.ca>. **Students who plan to attend Brescia University College should submit their OSAP documentation directly to Financial Aid at Brescia.** OSAP enquiries should be directed to Rachel Bruijns at extension 28382 or emailed to [brfinaid@uwo.ca](mailto:brfinaid@uwo.ca). OSAP students will be allowed to defer their fee payment until their OSAP funding is released. To qualify for a fee deferment, the student must have applied for OSAP by June 30, 2016 and submitted signature sheets and all other supporting documentation to Financial Aid at Brescia by July 4, 2016. The student must also have been notified of eligibility for OSAP before the fees are due and have sufficient first instalment of OSAP funding to cover at least the first instalment of tuition and/or residence fees that are due August 10, 2016. Before making any course changes, OSAP students are strongly recommended to visit The Hive at Brescia and speak with a representative to determine the financial implications, if any.
