

Welcome to Brescia University College! As a student registered at Brescia University College, you are required to enroll in a minimum of 3.0 credits at Brescia* in the Fall/Winter session. University regulations state that courses offered at Brescia, must be taken at Brescia. A full-time first-year program consists of 5.0 credits made up of courses numbered 1000 to 1999 including at least **four** different subject areas with no more than **two** courses in the same subject area. At least **one** credit (1.0) must be included from **each** of the **three** Categories (A, B and C – breadth requirements) before graduation.

Many courses at Western have a significant writing component. In order to recognize student achievement, a number of such courses have been designated as Essay Courses and will be identified on the student's record.
