To the Brescia community,

Today the provincial government made the decision for Middlesex-London region to move to [level Red \(Control\)](#) within the Ontario [COVID-19 response framework](#). This will come into effect on Monday, December 14th, 2020.

The move to “Red” does not affect Brescia’s operations significantly. All in-person exams will be held as planned; our classes are complete for the term.

We have worked hard to ensure Brescia continues to follow a stringent level of health and safety protocols, and are confident in the policies and protocols implemented. Our facilities team has gone above and beyond to follow these protocols, and will continue to ensure all in-person exam spaces are thoroughly sanitized between room occupancies. As well, all in-person exams at Brescia have been reduced significantly below the advised room capacity limits under the level “Red” designation.

I would like to assure our community that the number of on-campus exams at Brescia this term are limited, with the majority of exams being held online. I also understand that in-person exams may create concerns for students who have already traveled home (outside of the London region) and may feel cautious about returning to campus for an in-person exam.

Some of our students have already been working individually with the Registrar’s Office if they have personal circumstances that affect them and/or their ability to come to campus. If you are a student with concerns please don’t hesitate to contact the [Registrar’s Office directly](#).

The library will remain open throughout exams to provide ample study space, book pick-up, and print/copy/scan services. Students are asked to [pre-book their seat time](#) and reminded to fill out the [student questionnaire](#) each time they visit campus.

I appreciate all of the care taken by our community to keep each other safe and well. We will continue to update you as information becomes available. We have almost reached our goal; let us show kindness and support each other as we work together to successfully finish this term.
