BRESCIA SENIOR CITIZEN BURSARY GUIDELINES/ELIGIBILITY

Canadian citizens or permanent residents residing in Ontario and who will be 60 years of age or older during the first month their classes commence may be eligible for a bursary subject to the following conditions:

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant must be 60 years of age or older within the first month their study term commences.
2. Applicants must present proof of age when applying for the first time.
3. Applicant must be registered in Senate-approved courses or program in an undergraduate faculty.
4. Applicant may be registered as a full-time or part-time student for credit or audit.
5. Applicant must initially satisfy Brescia's entrance requirements for their chosen program or course(s).
6. Applications must be submitted prior to the start of classes for the session in which the bursary is required.
7. Applicant must declare financial need.

Notes:

- A. The value of the bursary shall cover up to the cost of tuition or the maximum of \$6000 per academic year (fall/winter) for undergraduate students. The bursary will not cover additional expenses such as books, sealing charges, late fees.
- B. Admission to limited enrolment courses and programs is competitive. No assurance is given to students that they will be granted a place in such courses or programs.
- C. Only students registered at Brescia University College and taking courses at Brescia University College are eligible. Students registered at Western University or affiliated University Colleges will not be considered for the bursary.
- D. Undergraduate students are required to submit an application for each fall/winter academic year.
- E. Applicant is responsible for submitting the bursary application prior to the tuition fee deadline. Bursary will not cover fees incurred from late or deferred charges.
- F. A reduction in course load will correspondingly reduce value of bursary; if adding or dropping courses during the academic year, please notify the Brescia Business Office by email or in writing.
- G. Students in receipt of other funding such as scholarships, awards or bursaries may have their Senior Bursary adjusted or cancelled.
- H. OSAP applicants will have the tuition costs on OSAP application adjusted depending on the value of the Senior Citizen Bursary.
