This is awarded by Brescia University College to an international undergraduate student with a minimum 70% average who is paying international student fees. The award is open to full-time students registered in years 1, 2, 3 or 4 at Brescia University College.

The recipient of the Ursuline International Award will receive:

- \$2,280 towards academic tuition applied to the 2021 – 2022 academic year

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants registering at Brescia for the first time who meet the admission average required for their program. Applicants currently registered at Brescia must meet progression requirements for their program.
- Applicants must be registered as a full-time undergraduate student at Brescia University College in September 2021.
- Applications for the Ursuline International Award must be received by **May 3rd, 2021**

The Ursuline Scholars International Award can be awarded in addition to an Entrance Scholarship (if applicable). This is a one year, non-continuing award.
